
ideas, and co-create a vision for a greener future.

Useful Tips

If you are traveling by air, the most convenient destination is Katowice Airport. From there, you can take a train to Český Těšín, either via Cieszyn or Bohumín, depending on your chosen route and schedule. Once you arrive in Český Těšín, we will arrange car transportation to the venue.

Feel free to contact us if you need help planning your route—we're happy to assist!

Travel

Participants must coordinate travel with their sending organizations.

- You may arrive up to 2 days before and depart up to 2 days after the project, but only the core project days (23–29 September) are covered.
- Please note that accommodation is provided from the evening of 23 September and is available until 12:00 PM on 29 September.
- Original travel documents (tickets, boarding passes, invoices) are required. Reimbursement will follow Erasmus+ rules based on the official distance calculator.

Need a lift? On request, we can arrange taxi transport from Katowice or Krakow airports directly to the venue. Please contact us in advance to coordinate and confirm the cost.

To ensure smooth coordination, please send your travel plans prior to the exchange.
