5. Pre-Departure Tasks (deadline 25 July 2025)

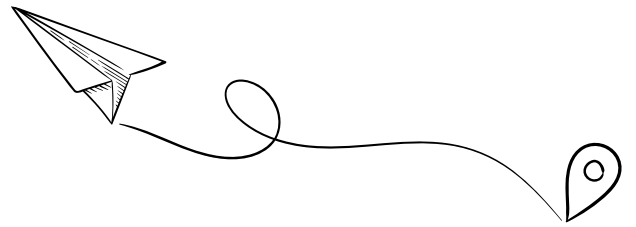
1. Finish the 20-min “Erasmus+ Youth Essentials” e-learning module.
2. Fill in the encrypted learning-journal template (link in welcome e-mail).
3. Prepare a 5-minute national-evening segment (snack, song, dance or quiz).
4. Create accounts in Bitrix24 (free plan) & Google Gemini.
Why? Completing these tasks saves workshop time, aligns with digital-skills objectives, and proves preparation phase for the NA.

6. What to Pack



1. Passport / ID (valid 6 months).
2. Laptop or tablet + charger (essential for AI labs).
3. Re-usable bottle & tote bag (green rule = no single-use).
4. Lightweight summer clothes (35 °C) + modest outfit for monastery visit.
5. National snacks & small flag for intercultural night.
6. Travel receipts & boarding passes (for reimbursement).
Why? Ensures comfort, inclusion and audit-proof finance docs.

7. Travel & Pick-Up



Please arrive at Zvartnots International Airport (EVN) on August 1st before 18:00. You'll find our team holding an NEF banner in the arrivals hall for a free group pick-up. Don't forget to complete the CO₂ log sheet by noting your mode of transport and the kilometers traveled for the Erasmus+ green indicators.

8. Accommodation & Meals



Please note that you'll be staying at the Capital Hotel (Aygedzor 53 B) in twin or triple ensuite rooms with Wi-Fi and a pool; buffet breakfast and dinner are served on-site and lunch is catered, and kindly submit your dietary requirements form by July 25th.

9. Financial Rules

Please note that the EU travel grant covers up to €275 for PL – AM and €180 for GE – AM participants based on distance bands; be sure to keep all your tickets and receipts and submit the originals on Day 6, and reimbursement will be made via bank transfer within 45 days of receiving your complete documentation.
